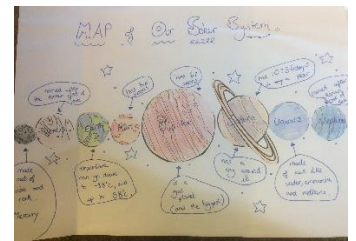




News and Homework for week beginning 7th May

This week in Maths... We started a new unit looking at symmetry, reflection and translation. We explored lines of symmetry in 2D shapes and learned how to reflect patterns in vertical, horizontal and diagonal lines of symmetry. Next, we linked this knowledge to reflect in the x and y axis before applying our skills to fluency, reasoning and problem solving questions.

In English... This week, we worked in groups to devise alternative endings to the 'Three Little Pigs' story. We storyboarded our ideas then acted them out to the rest of the class. Next, we planned our hot write newspaper articles based on our alternative endings, noting our ideas for content, features and language.



In other news... On Tuesday, we had fun practising maypole dancing in PE. In science, we learned about the planets in our solar system using fact cards to 'interview' the planets and designing our own posters. On Thursday, we enjoyed our ukulele lesson and now know a couple of different chords. We are also making good progress learning the words to the accompanying songs. In art, we applied the zentangle techniques we learned last week to begin our own wolf zentangle design. Finally, we would like to wish year 6 good luck with their SATs next week – GOOD LUCK!
