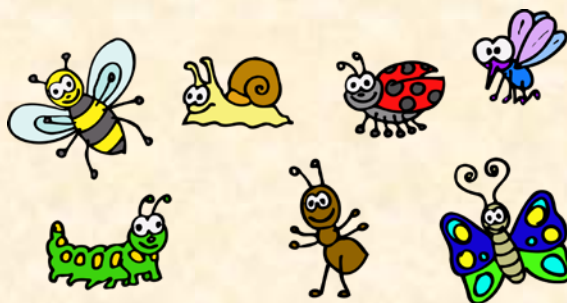
Maths

- Count to ten/twenty/hundred, forwards and backwards, beginning with 0 or 1, or from any given number.
- Count, read and write numbers to 10/20/100 in numerals and words.
- Represent and use number bonds and related subtraction facts within 10/20.
- Recognise place value of each digit in a two digit number.
- Read, write and interpret mathematical statements involving addition (+), subtraction (-) and equals (=) signs.
- Add and subtract one digit numbers to 10/20, including zero.
- Solve one step problems that involve addition and subtraction, using concrete objects and pictorial representations and missing number problems.
- Identify, represent and estimate numbers using different representations including the number line.
- Compare and order numbers from 0 up to 100; use <, > and = signs.
- Use place value and number facts to solve problems.
- Count in steps of 2, 3 and 5 from 0, and in tens from any number, forward and backward
- Recall and use addition and subtraction facts to 20 fluently, and derive and use related facts up to 100
- Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 2, 5 and 10 times tables, including recognising odd and even numbers.
