This week... Robots and Birthdays


In Maths... this week we have continued looking at dividing and sharing, and counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. Some of the children are still working on equal sharing as they tend to have a habit of 2 for me and 1 for you! We have used these skills to solve practical problems such as when we have 12 cakes and we share them with 12 people how many cakes do we each have? Please practice this at home - equal sharing.

In English... we have continued using the Rubbish Robot to help support our understanding of grammar, we have recapped what a noun, adjective, verb and adverb are as well as working with conjunctions to join or add more information to a sentence. We have also looked at suffixes and adding /s/ /es/ /ing/ to nouns and verbs. This is helping us improve our sentence writing and make it more interesting.

In other news... We spent a long afternoon discussing the history timeline from the big bang/creation of Earth to the present day. The children were fascinated. This then led us to look at the last 50 years and the development of robots. It's amazing how far technology has come in such a short time. In science we looked at the properties of materials and using scientific vocabulary to describe materials. We have three more swimming lessons left to gain our Fish Badges, the children are gain confidence and making progress, moving more freely around the pool, and floating and moving off. Please continue to encourage your child to blow bubbles in the bath water and get their face wet.
