



News and Homework for week beginning 18th September



THIS WEEK:

In Maths... this week we have continued to look at place value, investigating how numbers are formed and partitioned in different ways. We have also looked at ways of representation numbers and estimating numbers using different methods including the number line and dienes.

In English... We are using a short digital literacy film to engage writing which is called "A book of Butterflies." This week the children have been collecting nouns, adjectives and verbs to make sentences more interesting and collating them together to make super sentences. Some children have been working with their new sounds and playing lots of games to reinforce them.

In other news... We have looked at harvest this week, we started by looking at the different foods eaten across the world. We then read a book "The World Came to My Place Today" which explained where in the world different food came from. Then we looked at a specific food: crisps and watched how they are produced from the farm to the packet! Did you know you can get 36 crisps from one potato! We have been practising our harvest songs too and produced some super art work.
