**In Maths...** we have worked on our number bonds this week to 10, 20 and 100. Finding different ways to add numbers together quickly and looking for the patterns. We have practice two digit and 3 single digit addition using our knowledge of number bonds.

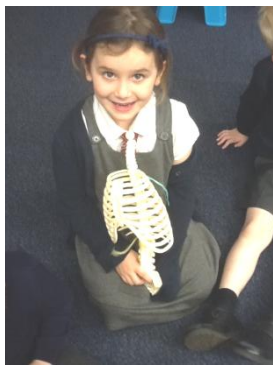
**In English...** this week we have played and created story maps for our own version of Owl Babies. We are writing the story up slow in parts, and have focused on character description and settings to start with. Some of the the children have created 3 baby bats that live in a bell tower, others have chosen 3 baby wolves in a deep dark cave. They are coming up with some fantastic language.

**In other news...** In healthy eating this week they talked about the muscles and bones that hold us together. They learnt about which bone is connected to which bone, this led to the skeleton coming out the cupboard - literally! We have also started to put together our Christmas Nativity, which as you can imagine takes a lot of effort! The children are already beginning to sing all the songs and their lines, now it's time to start to practice when it's their turn to speak and move!
