THIS WEEK: The Book of Butterflies, Harvest and Goats!

In Maths... this week we have looked at ordering numbers, ordinal numbers, as well as comparing numbers by looking at the concept of more and less, greater than and less than and equal to. We had used a lot of pictorial representations to help us understand these concepts. On Thursday we also practiced counting in 2s 5s and 10s when we grouped and counted the harvest festival goat money!

In English... Following on from the 'Book of Butterflies' film clip, this week we worked in groups and came up with our own ideas of what could come out of the book, we had three very different ideas, group 1: unicorns, group 2: sweets, group 3 monkeys and dogs: can you guess which groups your child was in? After planning their writing they used adjectives, nouns and verbs to write exciting short stories. Proud teacher!

In other news... We have continued our theme of healthy living and exercise with the children taking part in a round robin of activities explaining what makes us health and what exercises we can do! We are practising our cursive writing, which although tricky is really making an impact on writing, and we have made mini me's from collage material. We also attended our Harvest Festival Service where we all had a little bit to say, and did a brilliant job, as well as singing our hearts out!
