THIS WEEK: Guy Fawkes, Fireworks and Caves.

In Maths... addition and subtraction are still our focus this week, we have also been using the language of 'fewer' 'more' 'less' etc. Some children are working on counting on, rather than counting all, so holding a number in their head and adding on. Some children have been using counters to understand expanded column addition and counting on in 10s.

In English... we have looked at the poem "10 things found in a wizards pocket" by Ian McMillan. We liked its descriptive language and performed the poem. We then thought about ten things we would find in dark cave (because our new role play is a dark cave!), we came up with lots of ideas including, crackling fire, giant, hairy spiders and the bones of a dead dinosaur!

In other news... Our history expert Freddie, helped tell the story of Guy Fawkes, the children watched some clips to make it feel more real, we discussed where London and the Houses of Parliament were and talked about what might have happened if 36 barrels of gun powder had gone boooooom! The children were able to sequence the events in history and understood that this was British History and therefore not celebrated all around the world.
