



## Admissions

All admissions are dealt with through the Northamptonshire County Council ([www.northamptonshire.gov.uk](http://www.northamptonshire.gov.uk)).

We very much welcome visits from prospective parents. Please ring Mrs. Whitaker in the school office to arrange an appointment.

The school currently has a Published Admission Number of 12, meaning that 12 places are available for Early Years Foundation Stage Reception aged children each year.

The school is subject to the Community Primary Schools Rural Admission Criteria.

The school's **Linked Area** is Creaton, however in reality the school also admits children from the villages around Creaton and the Leicestershire border, such as Cottesbrooke, Thornby, Ravensthorpe and Hollowell, as well as from Brixworth and Kingsthorpe.

If the school is oversubscribed, places will be allocated to pupils who have a statement of SEN that names the school as appropriate provision.

When there are more applications for places than there are places available, priority will be given in the following order:

- (i) Children in public care or previously in public care but immediately after being looked after became subject to an adoption, residence or special guardianship order;
- (ii) Pupils who live in the linked area;
- (iii) Pupils with an older brother or sister continuing at the school at the time of admission of the younger child;
- (iv) Other pupils.

### **Tiebreaker:**

If the admission number is exceeded within (ii), priority will be given to those who live furthest from the nearest alternative school. If the admission number is exceeded within any other criterion, priority will be given to those who live closest to the school.
