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Religious Education

Religious Education (RE) is a statutory requirement for all schools but it is not part of the National Curriculum. It is part of the basic curriculum and therefore the syllabus is determined locally. The Agreed Syllabus for Religious Education used is the responsibility of the Local Authority (LA).

Because Religious Education is a local responsibility, Northamptonshire, like all Local Authorities has set up a Standing Advisory Council on Religious Education (SACRE) as is required by law, to give advice on the Agreed Syllabus and on RE generally within Community and Foundation Schools in the county.

The Agreed Syllabus for RE in Northamptonshire is called "Growing Together".



In Religious Education pupils work towards the following Attainment Targets:

Attainment Target 1: Learning about Religion and Belief

Attainment Target 2: Learning from Religion and Belief
